In 2013/14, the Peninsula Knights of Columbus dedicated almost 4,000 hours of their time to generate donations of over \$28,000 to help worthy causes in our Community.

We appreciate the Parish's essential support in helping us achieve our charitable endeavours'. We also recognize that many of the Knights and their families donated more than just time throughout the year. For example, furniture is picked up and stored throughout the year without any recognition of time and costs of those involved. It's not about making money, it's about helping those in need.

The Knights of Columbus wish to thank the many parishioners who made our recent garage and plant sale a great success, your donations and purchases were greatly appreciated. In addition we wish to thank the ladies of the parish (many of whom have no direct connection to the Knights) who helped set-up and run the event. We also wish to thank our Pastor and Parish Council for allowing us to use the church facilities and also helping with the event.

For your information we generated in excess of \$12,000 from our major activities supported by the church community, including approximately \$5,000 from the recent garage and plant sale. We were pleased to be able to donate almost \$10,000 of these funds to various causes. A further \$18,600 (resulting from our management and administration of funds allocated to the Council from BC Gaming) was donated to 25 good causes.
